

# OCEANSIDE HIGH SCHOOL 2021-2022

## AP POLICIES

**The AP exam policies and rules are set forth by this school and the College Board:**

- No students will be allowed admittance to exam rooms once exam has started.
- During scheduled or unscheduled breaks during exams, students are not allowed to consult textbooks, notes, or ask questions to teachers or other students. Do not use electronic or communication devices during breaks.
- All students must be dismissed from the exam room at the same time. No one may leave early (except in cases of illness or misconduct).

### **Exam Conflicts:**

- Some reasons for switching exam to late-testing date may incur an additional \$40 per exam late testing fee.
- Athletic/Sports conflict – It is your responsibility to check with your coach to determine if you will need to take any AP tests on an alternate date.

### **Exam Times:**

- A.M. Exams: 7:45 am check-in      Exam Time: 8:15 am to 12:00 pm
- P.M. Exams: 12:15 pm check-in      Exam Time: 12:45 pm to 4:30 pm

Students are released from testing all at the same time based on College Board regulations. Please do not schedule anything that would require your student to get out earlier than 4:00pm if they have an afternoon test.

### **WHAT TO BRING TO THE EXAM ROOM (Required items, you must bring):**

- 2 Sharpened No. 2 pencils (no mechanical )for multiple-choice answer sheet
- 2 Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams
- Current Government-issued or school-issued photo I.D.
- Up to 2 approved Calculators - if you are taking an AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Chemistry, AP Environmental Science, AP Physics, or AP Statistics Exam. - A ruler or straightedge only if you are taking an AP Physics Exam. Protractors are not allowed.

### **WHAT NOT TO BRING TO THE EXAM ROOM:**

- Electronic equipment including cell phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any other type of electronic or communication device.
- School-owned Chromebooks are allowed only for the AP Spanish Language and Culture Exam.
- Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, pencils that are not No. 2, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or colored pencils.
- Scratch paper; notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets
- Watches that beep, make a noise, or have an alarm (or Smart Watches).
- No food or drink in the exam room, including bottled water
- Computers or calculators that are not approved.
- Ear plugs.

## Breaks

During the break between Sections I and II of your AP Exam, or during any other unscheduled breaks, you are not allowed to consult textbooks, notes, teachers or other students; and you may not use any electronic or communication devices, like your cell phone, for any reason.

Also, you may not leave the building at any time during the exam administration, including during a scheduled break.

Remember, whether it's during breaks or after the exam, you must not communicate anything about the exam content to anyone, including your classmates and your teachers.

## Discussing Exam Questions

The AP Exam is intended to be a fair assessment of your academic ability. Sharing exam information in any unauthorized way compromises the integrity of the exam for all AP students, and for the colleges and universities that grant credit or advanced placement for qualifying AP scores.

If you post to any form of social media during the exam or refer to unreleased exam content at any time after the exam, your score will be canceled, no retest will be permitted, and you may be banned from future testing.

## Misconduct

You are also agreeing not to engage in misconduct during the AP Exam, including:

- Obtaining, or attempting to obtain, improper access to the exam, or a part of the exam, or information about the exam.
- Removing a page or portions of a page from the exam book.
- Attempting to remove from the testing room any part of the exam or any notes relating to the exam.
- Referring to, looking through, or working on any exam, or exam section, other than during the timed testing period for that exam or exam section.
- Accessing or attempting to access any prohibited aids.
- Accessing or attempting to access a phone of any kind or electronic device during testing or during breaks.
- Having subject-related information on your clothing, shoes, or body.
- Using testing accommodations not approved by College Board.
- Bringing food or drink into the testing room (unless it's approved as an accommodation by College Board).
- Leaving the testing room, building, or designated break area without permission and/or taking an extended break.
- Copying the work of another student or of published or unpublished sources.
- Attempting to give or get assistance, or otherwise communicate, through any means, with another person about the exam during the exam administration, including during breaks.
- Attempting to take the exam for someone else.
- Creating a disturbance.

If found doing these you may be asked to turn in your exam materials and leave the exam room. You may not return to the exam room, and your score will not be reported.
